# **INFORMATION FOR AUTHORS**

### We publish articles in five categories:

### • Theory and Methodology

We publish articles that make original contributions toward the basic theoretical development or methodology of statistics and probability. Articles should be motivated by scientific problems or practical applications and most preferably have real examples for demonstration.

#### • Applications and Case Studies

These types of articles should include the following essences:

- 1. Show scientific and statistical novelty in analysis of real data.
- 2. Show applications of existing statistical methods to new areas.
- 3. Introduce new and useful data, which are substantially important in certain fields of science and should be supplemented with the newly sound statistical methods.

#### • Reviewing Articles

Articles for reviewing certain topics.

#### • Short Articles or Commentary

This type of articles should have insightful views on a certain issue. The conclusion itself may not be new but the views must be different from known results. Manuscripts should be kept within 10 pages.

# • Letters to the Editor

- 1. Brief views and opinions toward the articles published in this journal.
- 2. Corrections of errors in articles published in this journal.

# **Manuscript preparation:**

- Manuscripts should be written in English. However, manuscripts in Chinese are also welcomed.
- To standardize the format, contributing articles should be written in the following composition: abstract, keywords, introduction, methods, examples or simulations, conclusion, references, tables and figures. If contributing in Chinese, please attach English title and abstract of around 300 words. For paper in English, please then attach the title and abstract in Chinese. Please refer to this journal's article format.
- All hand-drawn illustrations or photographs must be in serial order and kept to a size within 15cmx24cm. Text in images must be minimum 0.25cm (0.1in) in size, surrounded with a white border of 1.2cm (0.5cm), and serial numbers must be noted below each image.

#### **Manuscript submission:**

Manuscripts with PDF files should be submitted to <u>http://jcsa.stat.org.tw</u>. The file should not include names of authors, and source of research grants. Note that all the submitted manuscripts will be underwent by peer review with a double-blind process. Moreover, after the submitted manuscript was accepted, copyright would be turned over for the journal's possession.
