

## Guide for Authors

*Asia Pacific Management Review* (APMR) is an international journal founded in 1996. Each of four regular issues (March, June, September, and December) published each year contains scholarly articles, book reviews, and/or short communications related to enterprise or industry subjects. APMR sets out to stimulate thought and research in all aspects of management and to provide a forum for academics and professionals to share their knowledge and experience in the theory and practice of management. Research results relevant to the Asia Pacific region are most welcome.

Manuscripts submitted for publication in APMR are judged on the basis of their potential contribution to the advancement of the theory and/or practice of management. APMR authors demonstrate a strong knowledge of the literature of the field and research rigor. It is expected that an article published in APMR will contribute to the management field by offering new insights, new ideas, and/or new empirical results relevant and significant to the state of knowledge.

### Online Manuscript Submission

As of January 1<sup>st</sup> 2008, APMR requests authors to submit their manuscripts online at <http://apmr.management.ncku.edu.tw/> to the Journal's editorial office in order to keep the review time as short as possible. Our online manuscript submission and review system allows authors to track the progress of the review process. Revised submissions should be accompanied with a revision note in response to reviewers' comments. All correspondences, including requests for revision and the Editor's final decision, take place on the Author's homepage and via e-mails only. Therefore, authors need to keep their contact information on the registration page up-to-date with the "Edit Your Profile" option. Authors who are unable to use the online submission system may email the manuscripts along with supporting documents to the Editorial Office at [apmr@proj.ncku.edu.tw](mailto:apmr@proj.ncku.edu.tw). The APMR office and editors do not hold responsibility for damage or loss of manuscripts submitted.

### Submission Guidelines

1. Before submitting your manuscript for review, please make sure that your manuscript is prepared in accordance with paper format guidelines and the publication specifications. Please refer to Manuscript Preparation and Sample Manuscript for Submission for details. **Manuscripts without following the paper format guidelines will not be reviewed.**
2. Your manuscript will be reviewed with the understanding that it has not been published, nor is being submitted, accepted, or under review elsewhere. By submitting your manuscript, you warrant that the above statement is true.
3. Manuscripts submitted for publication in APMR are judged in terms of seven criteria: clarity of objectives, conceptual/theoretical quality, methodology quality, quality of interpretation of results, overall contribution to knowledge, organization quality, and readability.
4. Once you have logged in, use the "Submit New Manuscript" option to submit your new manuscript for review. To submit your revised manuscript, please use the "Track Your Article/Submit Revised Manuscript" option.
5. The acceptable file format for uploading is MS Word (.doc) format.
