Information for Authors Contributing Articles to Part A:

- 1. Bulletin of the Institute of Chemistry, Academia Sinica is published in March annually. Part A of the Bulletin publishes original articles, covering all fields in chemistry and closely related disciplines.
- 2. Manuscripts should be submitted in triplicate before January 15 and must be typewritten double-spaced on A4 paper.
- 3. Authors' names (primary author should be distinguished by *), research institute and correspondence address including postal code should be listed after title.
- 4. A short synopsis is required. It should state briefly the reason for the work, the significant results, and conclusions.
- 5. The paper should be subdivided into sections such as Introduction, Experimental, Results, Discussion, as well as Conclusion.
- 6. Nomenclature should be consistent, clear, and precise. Metric units (SI) should be used for all quantities. Nomenclature and symbols should follow the rules used by Chemical Abstracts Service or IUPAC.
- 7. References should be numbered consecutively in the order of their appearance in the text, with numbers as unparenthesized superscripts. The complete list of references should be typed on a separate page(s) and placed at the end of the manuscript. Journal abbreviations should be those used by *Chemical Abstracts*. Italics and bold-face character can be indicated by and ~~~, respectively.
- 8. Tables or Schemes should be numbered consecutively with Roman numerals and should be grouped at the end of the paper.
- 9. Figures should be numbered as "Figures", with Arabic numerals and all captions should be typed together on one or more separate sheets. Both figures and captions should be grouped together at the end of the manuscript. It is particularly important that all figures should be original drawings or good glossy photographs.
- 10. A synopsis together with authors' names and title in Chinese should also be prepared.
- 11. If the manuscript is prepared using IBM-compatible PC, a floppy-disk copy accompanied with the name of the used software will be very much helpful.
