

稿 約

1. 凡有關農業化學、生物化學、食品科學等之研究報告、論著，未曾在國內外發表或投稿者均為本刊徵稿對象。
2. 來稿使用Word文書作業軟體格式(.doc或.docx)，論著中、英文稿皆收。中文稿請於題目、摘要及關鍵字，附上中文與英文版本各一。文首內容須包括：題目、姓名、服務機構名稱、摘要與關鍵字，中文摘要總字數請勿超過五百字，英文摘要請勿超過三百字。英文稿則無須提供中文摘要。一經刊登，將致贈給作者其文章之電子檔。
3. 外文名詞，請參照教育部分佈之「化學命名原則」、「化學工程名詞」、「食品科技名詞」等翻譯。
4. 文稿必須包含摘要、前言、材料與方法、結果、討論(或結果與討論)、結論、致謝及參考文獻。
5. 文稿必須編著頁碼並於左邊加註行號。附表請於表頭以表一、表二等，並附標題說明。附圖請於圖下以圖一、圖二等，並說明圖意。中文稿件圖表均以英文表示併附中文標題，以Table 1、Table 2或Fig. 1、Fig. 2開頭，置於中文標題之下。註腳請以1、2表之。
6. 章節之劃分如下：章不冠數字，用大體字置於文之正中。節用一、二、三等，置於文之左端，小節則以1、2、3等，自左端二格書寫。小節之下分項，則用英文字母(a)、(b)、(c)等比照小節退二格書寫。
7. 引用文獻，以引用先後為序，Endnote檔案可於期刊網址下載(<https://www.ipress.tw/J0133>)。內文引用以括號文獻編號上標於引用句末；文末文獻書寫之排列為：著者之名(或簡寫)、姓(中文則先姓後名)、題目、刊物名稱或書名、卷期數或版別、頁數、發行年份。刊物名稱請以學術界通用方式縮寫，書籍則請加註出版書局，例如：

8. 本刊文稿每篇以六千字左右為最適宜，如排版後篇幅超過印刷頁數六頁，超過部份之印刷費用須由著者負擔，其費用為500-1000 NTD/頁。如需封面或單行本請註明份數於稿件中，其費用由著者負擔。
9. 內容簡短或負面結果可以Research Note方式刊出。
10. 會誌上發表之文章，如需彩色印刷，其費用為6000 NTD/頁，由著者自付。
11. 本論文責由著者自負。
12. 稿件經本刊接受並打字排版後，其第二次校對由著者負責，但僅得就排印錯誤之處加以修正。

Instructions to Authors

1. The aim of this journal is to publish the research papers in the fields of agricultural chemistry, biochemistry, and food science, etc.
2. Submission of an **original paper** (not more than 6000 words) or **research note** implies that it has not been published previously (except in the form of an abstract or as part of a published lecture or academic thesis), that it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere, and that, if accepted, it will not be published elsewhere in the same form without the written consent of the Publisher. Academic research and science news, research viewpoint, and review articles are also welcomed. The manuscripts written in either **Chinese** or **English** are accepted.
3. The manuscript must be submitted in .doc or .docx, be typed double-spaced, **labeled page and line numbers**, and arranged according to the following format: **ABSTRACT, INTRODUCTION, MATERIALS AND METHODS, RESULTS, DISCUSSION or RESULTS AND DISCUSSION, CONCLUSIONS, ACKNOWLEDGMENTS, REFERENCES.**
4. **Pagination.** Page sequence of articles should be as follows:
 - Title page.** Topic should not exceed 40 words and typed in capitals of initial of each word. Topic in both English and Chinese should be provided if the manuscript was written in Chinese. Full name(s) of author(s) of capitals of initial, administrative unit/department/section contact person, and address, telephone and fax numbers and e-mail address for correspondence. The corresponding author should be identified with an asterisk and footnote. Please give a short "Running title" of manuscript.
 - Second page.** Single paragraph abstract and a list of keywords should be provided in both English and Chinese if the manuscript was written in Chinese. The abstract should not exceed 300 words in English and 500 words in Chinese. No Chinese abstract and keywords are required for manuscripts written in English.
 - Third page.** Complete text, references, tables, figure captions, figures.
5. **Nomenclature**

Current recognized (IUPAC) chemical nomenclature should be used, although commonly accepted trivial names may be used where there is no risk of ambiguity.
6. Photographs, charts and diagrams are all to be referred to as "Figure(s)". They should accompany the manuscript, but should not be included within the text. All illustrations should be clearly marked with the figure number. Every figure and table should have a caption. Captions should be provided in a separate page in the manuscript. Tables should be numbered consecutively and given a suitable caption and each table typed on a separate sheet. Footnotes to tables should be typed below the table and should be referred to by superscript lowercase letters. No vertical rules should be used. Tables should not duplicate results presented elsewhere in the manuscript (e.g. in graphs). Photographic materials must be original prints.
7. **References.** References should be listed on a separate sheet and numbered in the order in which they are cited in the text. References should be cited in the text by a superscript number in parentheses, for example, ⁽¹⁾. The Endnote format could be downloaded at the website below.

Journals: initials followed by author(s)' last name(s); complete title; journal title, volume number, first and last page numbers; year of publication.

Example:

Books: initials followed by author(s)' last name(s); complete title; edition and volume; name of editor; first and last page numbers; publisher; place of publication; year of publication.

8. Proofs and reprints

Proofs. Galley proofs are made available to only the corresponding author of a paper. It is the responsibility of the corresponding author to ascertain that all coauthors agree with the corrections before the corrections are returned.

Reprints. Author(s) must be responsible for the charge of color pages (6000 NTD/page) and extra pages in print if total page numbers are more than six after the editing (500-1000 NTD/page). One electronic copy for author will be emailed. The reprints and additional copies of the issue can be ordered at a specially reduced rate by contacting publisher.

9. Copyright.

Upon submitting the manuscript, authors are required to send the copyright (for copyright agreement letter download please see <http://www.agrichem.org.tw> or www.food.org.tw) to the associations. The copyright agreement must be uploaded with the manuscript to editor-in-chief before reviewing process is proceeded. If excerpts from other copyrighted works are included, the author(s) must obtain written permission from the copyright owners and credit the source(s) in the article.
