Information for Authors

1. JMBE is the official journal of the Biomedical Engineering Society of the R.O.C., which publishes articles about medical instruments, computer application in medical science, biomechanics, biomaterials, biomedical engineering application, physiological emulation and other related topics. You are welcome to contribute your article on the above mentioned subjects that is not published in other publication and not sent to other publishers.
2. The length of a published paper should not exceed six pages, and communication notes should not exceed four pages. Each page shall contain about 1,700 words; charts/diagrams/graphs are included in the total pages. Articles contributed within the stipulated range are free. A payment of NT\$3000/per page is required for the cost of extra pages. The contributor has to pay for all additional expenses as to any color pages or photoengraving.
3. The article is to be typed out **double-spaced, 12 pt** in English. It should include an abstract of around 300 words. The contents should be arranged in the following order: abstract, keywords, introduction, materials and methods, results, discussion, conclusion, and references. Any note of appreciation and symbol reference should following charts/diagrams/graphs. Captions in sequential order should be place before the reference literature.
4. The title of the article should be typed on the front page. The subject should be concise, and its English title should be typed in capitals. The author's name, office, mailing address and telephone number should be listed below the subject heading of the article. Please indicate each author and submit a service organization in Chinese or in English.
5. The printed charts/diagrams/graphs should be clear and at least 300 dpi. Please place the figures in the order in which they are referred to in the text.
6. The referenced contents should be offered and numbered at the end of the sentence according to the sequential order of the quotations applied. If the referenced content is from a periodical journal, please mention the name of the author, the subject, the periodical, the issue number, the volume number, the page number(s), the year and of publication according to the correct sequential order. If the quoted content is from a book, please mention the name of the author, the book, the published place, the name of the publisher, the year of the publication, the publication, the chapter, the section, the page number(s) of the book according to the right sequential order. Some examples are given as follows:
For a paper:

For a conference paper:

7. The submitted manuscripts must use Metric Units in text. Use only standard symbols and abbreviations unless defined when first used in the text.
8. The author is allowed two revisions before the article is published. Please try to proof read carefully.
9. The copyright of the article in this journal will belong to the Society. The author will be given 30 reprint copies free of cost, but if more are required, s/he should pay the extra cost for the copies.
