

Information for Authors

Types of Contributions

Upon acceptance of a paper, authors will be requested to supply their biographies (100 to 200 words) and the final version of their manuscript on a computer diskette along with the hard copy. The manuscripts should be typed by Microsoft Word 7.0 (or above), or Latex and submitted to the Executive Editor. Electronic submission (in doc, or zip compressed postscript) of manuscripts is required.

Manuscripts

Submitted manuscripts must be typewritten in English. All submitted manuscripts should be as concise as possible. Regular papers are normally limited to 16 pages (Final typed page). The length of paper exceeds 20 pages are strongly discouraged. The Editor reserves the right to refuse to consider such papers.

Style for Manuscript

Papers should be arranged in the following order of presentation:

1. First page must contain: Title of Paper (without Symbols), Author(s) and affiliation(s), Abstract: include 4-6 suggested keywords, Complete mailing address, telephone number, and, if available, electronic mail (E-mail) address and facsimile (FAX) number of each author, Preferred address for correspondence & return of proofs, and Footnotes (if desired).
2. The text.
3. Acknowledgements of financial or other support (if any).
4. References:

Review processing

All papers submitted to *International Journal of Kansei Information* will be preceded at least two blind committee reviews, Submissions will be evaluated on the basis of originality, importance of contribution, soundness, evaluation, quality of presentation, and appropriate comparison to related work, the reviewing process will normally take three months.

Style for Illustrations

1. Original drawings should be in black ink on white background. Maximum size is restricted to 15 by 22.7 cm. Glossy prints of illustrations are also acceptable.
2. All lettering should be large enough to permit legible reduction of the figure to column width, sometimes as small as one quarter of the original size. Typed lettering is usually not acceptable on figures.
3. Provide a separate sheet listing all figure captions, in proper style for the typesetter, e.g., “Figure 5 The basic concept of *kansei*”

Page Charges

After a manuscript has been accepted for publication, the publication fee US \$ 100 for one paper(include 5 reprints). A mandatory over length page charge of US \$ 25 is required for each page in excess of 4 pages for a paper. The reprint for 10 is US \$ 25, and so on (maximum: 20 reprints)

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
