## **Information for Prospective Contributors**

- 1. MLA style for literature/ APA style for linguistics and language teaching
- 2. Manuscripts should be double-spaced and typeset in 12-point Times New Roman. The notes should appear in the form of footnotes.
- 3. Papers are normally limited to 20 pages in length, inclusive of 150-word abstracts in English and Chinese separately, with a reasonable number of keywords below.
- 4. As the essays will be evaluated by two anonymous reviewers chosen by the editorial committee, a referee fee of NT\$ 2000 will be charged. (\*the author's name and address should appear only on the cover sheet of manuscript listing author's name, essay title, mailing address, phone number, and email address.)
- 5. Upon acceptance, the author will submit a copy of the final printed version together with an exact copy by email, and do the proofreading.
- 6. The author will receive one copy of the journal and fifteen off-prints of the article upon publication.
