

Instruction to Authors

1. The journal is devoted to the publication of **original articles and brief communications** related with **any field of genetics and molecular biology**. It is published quarterly.
2. Manuscripts should be typewritten in **English**, double spaced. **Attachment of a computer disc is recommended**. The manuscript needs original with tables and figures to facilitate editing.
3. The manuscript should be prepared in the following sequence: **title page-the first page-includes title, author's name with full spelling, institutes and abstract, key words and running title. Corresponding author is written at last**.
4. The second page is started by **introduction** then **materials and methods, results, discussion, acknowledgement, references, legends for figures, and tables**. Tables and figures should be submitted separately.
5. **Key words** should include 2-5 terms, and a running title with a maximum of 40 lower case letters.
6. **Tables and figures** should be numbered in two separate sequences in the order in which they are mentioned in the text. Each table should be typed, double spaced, on a separate sheet and should have a short informative caption. Each column of the table should have a short heading, and footnotes may be used for explanations (e.g., abbreviations).
7. Figures must be provided in camera-ready form. The figure number, author's name, and top/bottom should be marked on the back. They need perfectly draw, label and photograph. **Lettering and symbols on figures should be large enough to be easily recognized after size reduction**.
8. References.:
References are listed by the order of their appearance in the text. Citation in the text should be indicated in brackets [] with Arabic numerals immediately following the citation.
