2024 年《台灣舞蹈研究》第十九期「動作分析:身體的探索與實踐」專題徵稿啟事

期刊簡介

《台灣舞蹈研究》的創刊宗旨,在於鼓勵並提倡舞蹈及相關領域之學術研究,舉凡舞蹈史、舞蹈教育、舞蹈美學、舞蹈文化研究、舞蹈社會學、舞蹈人類學、舞蹈民族誌、舞蹈身心學、舞蹈現象學、拉邦研究、舞蹈/動作分析、身體文化研究、舞蹈與科技、舞蹈創作與展演相關之理論,以及其他跨領域的舞蹈研究論文,均歡迎賜稿。

本期專題

「動作分析:身體的探索與實踐」

拉邦在《動作語言,空間和諧準則》(The Language of Movement—The Guidebook to Choreutics)—書中提到在動力發生剎那,—連串自然的動力組合之中,必然包含了內在的心理狀態(Laban, 1976)。

動作分析是關心動作、關心身體者,在研究中必須探尋的必經過程。這種對動作的關注,經常延伸至舞蹈、表演藝術,各種使用身體的領域。而相關的學理,通常以拉邦理論為主,在「拉邦動作分析」(Laban Movement Analysis)的學理中,可經由肢體與空間、時間、環境的關係,顯現出動作質地的各種可能性,也促成各門各派的身心學之茁壯發芽。舞蹈界中對身體、動作分析、表演實踐者,以及舞蹈研究者,經常運用「拉邦動作分析」施用到各種不同的領域,包括舞蹈教育、舞蹈健康、幼兒發展、企業管理、精神病患治療等。在學術研究方面,被擴展使用的,還概括了心理學、運動學、社會學、人類學、犯罪學等。

本期專題「**動作分析:身體的探索與實踐**」,鼓勵投稿者不必只拘泥於「拉邦動作分析」學理,歡迎提出更寬廣的相關論點、新見解,來研究動作、身體。希望投稿者帶入其他身體、動作的學理,舉出自己獨立之創意見解,帶入自己的想法,與大家共享。

歡迎與**舞蹈、身體**相關議題:教育或教學的研究,表演、創作的探討,歷史的探詢,社會、文化脈絡對舞蹈、動作的影響,或表演藝術科技的研伸討論、理論與實踐的互扣。

以上議題之外,凡是舞蹈、身體相關之學術論述皆歡迎投稿。

文稿類別

- 1. 研究論文(research article): 具原創性且未經出版之正式論文(中文以不超過 20,000 字/英文不超過 10,000 為原則),如在學術會議上發表過的論文,請予以註明。
- 2. 書評(book review):舞蹈相關的書評(中文以不超過 5,000 字/英文不超過 3,000 字為原則)。
- 3. 翻譯著作(translated article):外文經典的舞蹈論著之中譯(中文以不超過 20,000 字/英文不超過 10,000 字為原則)。

投稿日期與期程

- 1. 本期期刊截稿日期: 2024年5月1日。
- 2. 初審結果: 2024年8月1日前公布, 並透過電子郵件通知作者。

3. 作者必須依照審查委員之意見於 <u>2024 年 9 月 1 日前</u>完成修正,同時 以電子郵件回傳本刊。複審通過後本刊將於七日內給予正式的通知。

4. 本期期刊預計將於 2024 年 12 月出刊。

投稿資格

- 1. 投稿人為非台灣舞蹈研究學會之有效會員,須繳付新台幣 2,000 元整。台灣舞蹈研究學會之有效會員,審稿費為新台幣 1,000 元整。

3. 投稿人之稿件一經交付審查,請即依審查結果進行後續修改程序,不 得撤稿,以免造成審查資源浪費及出版困擾。依台灣舞蹈研究學會規 定,撤稿者於當期之後,三年內不得再行投稿。

審查制度

- 1. 本期刊為<u>雙盲匿名審查制</u>:所有來稿均經編輯委員會初審後,送請專家學者匿名審查,通過後始予刊登,若兩位委員意見相左,則安排第三位委員審稿。
- 2. 審查等級與意見:審查結果分四等級:
 - (1) 通過,照原文刊登;
 - (2) 修改後通過;
 - (3) 修改後,再審;

- (4)不通過。
- 3. <u>審稿標準</u>:研究主題重要性、方法嚴謹度、見解創新、格式一致,所獲 結論具學術或實用價值,且對舞蹈研究、藝術、教育具有實質的貢獻。

稿件格式

- 1. 「投稿稿件」文書格式:以 Word 檔案繳交以利校稿。請以 Microsoft Office 軟體編輯,橫向排列,標準邊界,中文 12 號新細明體,英文字體為 Times New Roman,註明頁碼。
- 2. 請勿於「投稿稿件」正文中出現作者姓名或任何足以辨識作者身分之 資料。
- 3. 「投稿稿件」請依下列順序排列:
 - (1)封面(個人資訊頁):論文中英文題目、論文類別、稿件字數、 作者中英文姓名、中英文任職機構與職稱、通訊地址、聯絡電 話、電子郵件件帳號。
 - (2) 中文摘要(500字以內)及關鍵詞(5個以內)
 - (3) 英文摘要(300字以內)及英文關鍵詞(5個以內)
 - (4) 正文
 - (5)參考書目
 - (6) 附錄(若有請編碼,若無則免附)
- 4. 論文寫作格式:請依循《台灣舞蹈研究》APA 最新撰稿體例格式書寫(《台灣舞蹈研究》撰稿體例請見期刊網站)。
- 5. 若「投稿稿件」之作者多於一人,請註明每位作者對文章的貢獻,並 符合學術倫理之規範。

著作版權

- 1. 投稿稿件之論文,不得有一稿多投、侵害他人著作權或違反學術倫理等情節。如有違反,一切責任由作者自負,且三年內作者不得投稿本刊,並視情節嚴重程度求償。
- 2. 論文內使用之圖片,作者需自行處理版權問題。
- 3. 譯稿須事先徵得原作者同意,且文責自負。
- 4. 投稿稿件一經接受,投稿者必須在出刊前簽署著作財產權讓與書。
- 5. 投稿稿件一經刊登,紙本與數位的著作財產權即屬本刊所有,作者重新刊登或結集出版(紙本或數位)時,請務必知會台灣舞蹈研究學會,並在轉載文中註明原始刊載處。
- 6. 投稿人的授權範圍包括,「非專屬授權」本刊簽約的資料庫業者, 進行數位化、重製等加值流程後收錄於資料庫,並以電子形式透過單 機、網際網路、無線網路或其他公開傳輸方式,提供用戶進行檢索、 瀏覽、下載、傳輸、列印等(著作財產權讓與書請見期刊網站)。
- 7. 編審委員會得視編輯之需要,決定文章刊登之期數。

Taiwan Dance Research Journal Vol. 19 (2024) Call for Submissions Special Issue:

"Movement Analysis: Exploration and Practice of the Body"

Taiwan Dance Research Journal (TDRJ) is dedicated to disseminating quality academic research in dance and dance-related fields. We welcome scholarly articles on the subjects of dance history, dance education, dance aesthetics, culture studies in dance, dance sociology, dance ethnography, somatics, dance phenomenology, dance documentation, dance/movement analysis, choreological studies, dance and technology, as well as interdisciplinary research papers on dance. Although we call for specific manuscripts, we welcome submissions on general dance-related topics other than the theme of the issue.

Theme

Movement Analysis is a necessary research process for persons concerned about movement and the body. More often than not, this attention to movement extends to dance, performing arts, and the various fields of using the body. For this, the scholarly theory is frequently Laban theory. In the theoretical Laban Movement Analysis (LMA), various possibilities of movement qualities are visible through the relationship between the body with space, time, and environment. It also contributed to the growth of multiple schools of body-mind learning. In dance, practitioners of body, movement analysis, performance, and dance researchers often use LMA in different fields, including dance education,

dance wellness, early childhood development, business management, mental patients' treatment, etc. Scholarly research has expanded to include psychology, kinesiology, sociology, anthropology, criminology, etc.

The theme of this issue: "Movement Analysis: Exploration and Practice of the Body" encourages applicants not to stick only to the theory of Laban Movement Analysis. We welcome broader, relevant, related points of discussion and new insights in the study of movements and bodies. We wish to see article submissions bring in other theories of movement and the body, present independent creative insights, and bring in individual ideas to share with everyone.

Any related discussion in research and practice to the Movement and the Body in Dance is welcomed, be it in education, pedagogy, performance and choreography, history, society, culture or performing technology.

In addition to the topics above, all academic papers related to dance can be submitted.

* The theme is designed by Professor Yunyu Wang, the School of Dance, Taipei National University of the Arts.

Types of Submissions

Each paper could be of

- 1. **Original research article.** Each article should not exceed 20,000 words of Mandarin texts/10,000 of English texts, with notes and works cited included.
- 2. **Review.** Dance-related book. Each review should not exceed 5,000 words of

Mandarin texts/3,000 words of English texts.

3. **Translated article.** Chinese translation of distinctive dance research in a foreign language. Each translation should not exceed 20,000 words of Mandarin texts/10,000 words of English texts.

Deadline

- 1. The deadline for all submissions is the 1st of May 2024.
- 2. All authors will receive an e-mail notification of acceptance by the 1st of August 2024.
- 3. Authors who accepted the offer should complete and submit by e-mail their final draft to *TDRJ* on/before the 1st of September 2024. All authors will be notified of the final editorial decision in one week
- 4. This issue is scheduled to be published in December 2024.

Eligibility

Author should make a remittance of NT\$1,000 (or NT\$2,000 if none-member) to TDRS account (provide below) for his/her article review.

Clause. According to the TDRS regulation, authors are not to withdraw submitted articles. An author who withdraws the submitted article will not be

allowed to make any submission to *TDRJ* within the next three years.

Reviewing Process

TDRJ is a refereed journal. All articles will be blind reviewed by two or three scholars. The authors should not indicate their names or identities in any forms in their writings. The review committee will send the reviewers' comments to each author along with the editorial recommendation.

Editorial Recommendation

- 1. Publishable as it is
- 2. Minor revisions
- 3. Major revisions
- 4. Reject

Format

- 1. Manuscripts should be in Microsoft Office, with Normal Margin, 12 pt. Times New Roman font, with page numbering.
- 2. Manuscripts should be arranged in the order of,
 - (1) Cover sheet

with personal information to include:

- Title of the manuscript (in Chinese and English)
- Type of submission
- Number of words
- Author's name (in Chinese and English)
- Author's affiliation (in Chinese and English)
- Author's postal address, telephone number and e-mail address

(2) Abstract

- Manuscripts in the Mandarin language medium will provide a 500word abstract in Mandarin with five keywords and a 300-word abstract in English with five keywords.
- Manuscripts in the English language medium will provide a 300-word abstract in English with five keywords.
- (3) Body of the text (authors should not indicate their names or identities in any form in their writings)
- (4) References (APA Style, the newest version)
- (5) Appendices

Copyright

- 1. *TDRJ* does not accept previously published articles or those submitted and accepted for publication elsewhere. Articles should contribute original material. *TDRJ* requires all authors to sign a copyright form stating that their submitted work has not been published. The signed copyright form must be submitted with the article.
- 2. Authors must obtain permission to publish photographs if taken by other individuals.
- 3. Written permission of the original author should be obtained before submitting a translated article.
- 4. Authors are fully responsible and liable for any form of plagiarism.
- 5. *TDRJ* copyrights each issue of the journal as a collective work. Individual authors must retain rights to their works. Authors of individual works published in *TDRJ* have the right to republish their work in whole or in part. All re-publications must be credited with the published initially *TDRJ*

volume and page number.

- 6. *TDRJ* requires authors to assign their copyright to the journal once an article has been accepted. The signed Copyright Assignment Agreement must be received before the article is published.
- 7. The copyright obtained by the journal includes the authorization of contracted digital archives to collect and disseminate the work in digital forms.

Clause. Contributors will receive five complimentary copies of the issue in which their articles were published.

Submission

- 1. This journal is supported by a digital online submission and review system. Contributors, please log in to https://www.ipress.tw/J0263 to register a new account before uploading manuscripts in Word files. If the system shows that you already have an account, please log in to your account and update your basic information.
- 2. Contributor's final script must be in Chinese or English text of a Word.docx file. It should include Chinese and English abstracts and keywords, main body text, and cited references.
- 3. Upon submission, please upload the remittance receipt for the review fee in the designated field.
