- 1. 本刊採横式(由左至右)寫作,請用新式標點符號。「」用於平常引號, 『』用於引號內之引號;《》用於書名,〈〉用於論文及篇名;西文書 名用 *Italic*;論文篇名用 "";古籍或經典之書名與篇名連用時,可省略 篇名符號,如《史記・刺客列傳》、《妙法蓮華經·藥草喻品》。
- 2. 論文章節標號:中文請依一,(一),1.,(1),(a);英文以 I,1.,(1), A,(a) 依序排列;前言、序論、結論、結語皆佔一章節標號。引文超 過三行,須獨立成段,全段由左縮排三個中文字元,書型改爲楷書體, 不必另加引號,出處之註明採頁下注。引文未超過三行者,則於引語前 後加「」。公元年代、計數請使用阿拉伯數字。
- 3. 中、西文於行文中混合出現時,標點符號之使用以符號前一字為準。 圖表、照片請注明資料來源,引用時請以阿拉伯數字注明編號,勿使用 「如前圖」、「見右表」等表示方法。來稿提供圖片解析度須達 300dpi 以上。
 - 請勿使用:「同上」、「同前引書」、「同前書」、「同前掲書」、「同 注幾引書」,"ibid.,""Op. cit.,""loc. cit.,""idem"等。
- 4. 論文正文中資料引用一律採「頁下注」,請依序注明作者,書名(或篇名), 頁碼。

- 一、《華人宗教研究》爲一國際性學術期刊,園地公開;凡關於華人宗教研究 之論著,均歡迎海內外學者賜稿。
- 二、《華人宗教研究》刊載中、英文純學術之論文及書評,不收載譯述之作品。中文稿件,論文以不超過30000字、書評以不超過5000字為原則;英文稿件,論文以不超過20000英文字、書評稿件以不超過2000英文字為原則(以微軟 Word文字處理軟體的字數統計為準)。書評論文視為論文。特約稿件則無字數長度之限制。
- 三、《華人宗教研究》,每年 1 月及 7 月出版。來稿以未曾發表者爲限;已在網路上發表的文章,亦不予收錄。凡發現一稿兩投者,日後《華人宗教研究》不再刊載其作品。
- 四、《華人宗教研究》不負責來稿內容之著作權問題(如圖、表、照片及長引文等),請先行取得著作權持有者之同意。來稿請勿發生侵害第三人權利之情事,如有抄襲、重製或侵害等情形發生時,概由投稿者負擔法律責任,與《華人宗教研究》無關。來稿所附圖片以請提供高解析度(解析度 300dpi 以上)的圖檔,以確保印刷品質。

- 七、《華人宗教研究》對來稿之文字有刪改權,如不願刪改者,請於來稿上註 明。
- 八、凡通過審查刊登之論文,作者需簽署「著作財產權讓與同意書」交予《華 人宗教研究》。《華人宗教研究》著作者享有著作人格權,《華人宗教研究》 享有著作財產權;日後除著作者本人將其個人著作結集出版外,任何人 基於任何目的之翻印、轉載、翻譯等皆須事先徵得《華人宗教研究》同 意後,使得爲之。
- 九、《華人宗教研究》之論文(含書評)亦將規劃以電子檔形式在網路上發行,若僅同意以紙本形式發表者,請投稿時特別註明。作者投稿本刊,經本刊收錄後,同意以「無償非專屬授權」的方式,授權本刊另外再授權其他本刊所授權之資料庫業者進行重製、透過網路授權用戶下載、列印、瀏覽等行為。
- 十、來稿經審查刊登後,贈送作者當期期刊 2 本、論文之 pdf 檔,與上期期刊 1 本,不另支付稿酬。未經採用之稿件,恕不退還,請自留底稿。

Studies in Chinese Religions Call for Papers

- [1] Studies in Chinese Religions is an international scholarly journal that accepts papers from the public. Authors are welcome to submit papers concerning Chinese religions, both from authors in Taiwan and abroad, for publication.
- [2] Papers or reviews published in *Studies in Chinese Religions* must be original scholarship; no translations from previously published material are allowed. Papers written in Chinese must not exceed 30,000 characters, and reviews must not exceed 5,000 characters. English articles must not exceed 20,000 words (please check word count using Microsoft Word). The word limit for review articles is the same. With permission of editor, special articles may exceed the word limit.
- [3] Studies in Chinese Religions is published every June and December. Articles must not have previously been published; if the articles have appeared on the Internet, they are also not permitted for publication. If it is later discovered that an author published an article elsewhere, he or she will not be permitted to publish in this journal again.
- [4] Studies in Chinese Religions will not take responsibility for copyright (e.g., illustrations, tables, pictures, extended quotes). Authors must obtain permission for copyrighted material prior to submitting to the journal. It will also be the author's responsibility if there is any infringement on a third party's rights. In cases such as plagiarism or reduplication, the author is fully responsibility for these actions. Studies in Chinese Religions will not be involved in a legal case, if it is brought against an author. If an article has more than four pages of illustrations or more than ten illustration total, an author must obtain permission from the editor before the article can be published.
- [5] All papers will undergo anonymous review prior to publication, and this will be followed by an administrative review. The article must be passed by the committee members before it can be accepted for publication. There is no way that this process can be expedited. If the article is accepted for publication, the journal will provide written proof to the author. Authors must allow the journal adequate time to review articles; please do not submit an article if you plan to submit it elsewhere.

- [6] Please follow the formatting guidelines as specified by *Studies in Chinese Religions*. All articles should have an English and Chinese title. Research articles should also provide keywords in English and Chinese, as well as a 350 characters abstract in Chinese. Book Review should include the book's title and author.
- [7] Studies in Chinese Religions reserves the right to make editorial changes to a paper. If an author does not wish to have the changes made, please specify when submitting an article.
- [8] After an article has been accepted, authors must sign a form that will give the copyright of the article to *Studies in Chinese Religions*. Authors will still have the right to use their name, but all financial rights will belong to *Studies in Chinese Religions*. If an authors wishes to republish the content of this article, either retyped in a book or as a facsimile, authors must gain the permission of *Studies in Chinese Religions* before this republication is allowed.
- [9] All research articles and reviews in *Studies in Chinese Religions* will be available in an online format. If authors wish an article to only be published in paper format, he or she must state this clearly when submitting the article. Before an article is published, an article must sign a form that will authorize the journal to disseminate the article without compensation to the author. If, in the future, the journal sells the content to a different database, authors will not be notified of any such changes.
- [10] All contributors of the journal will receive two issues of the journal, as well as pdf file of the article and a copy of the last issue. All unaccepted article will not be returned; we apologize for any inconvenience.
- [11] Studies in Chinese Religions is typeset digitally, so all articles must be submitted as a Microsoft Word file. Every article must contain the following information: a Chinese and English title, a Chinese (350 characters limit) and English abstract, Chinese and English keywords (3–5 words), and a bibliography. In a separate document, please write your Chinese and English name, institution, professional title, address, phone number, fax number, and email; this will help us contact you about your publication. You may also reach us via email at cscrtw@gmail.com. Please do not submit an article elsewhere after submitting to this journal.
